A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI,
OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM,
GRANTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT
AND TECHNOLOGY, SPORTS AND EVENTS PROMOTION; AND GRANTS
AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR CULTURE, ARTS, AND TOURISM, CULTURE AND ARTS PROGRAM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5657, Bill No. 60, CD1, FD2 (2024), as amended "Fiscal Year 2025 Budget", Section 3.B.12.c.(2).(xxv).(a), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, Sports and Events Promotion, is amended to decrease the appropriation and condition for Maui County residents for participation in and hosting of events, in the amount of \$20,000, to read as follows:

This bill proposes to amend the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget, by: 1) amending Section 3.B.12.c.(2).(xxv).(a), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, Sports and Events Promotion, by decreasing the appropriation and condition for Maui County residents for participation in and hosting of events, in the amount of \$20,000; and 2) amending Section 3.B.12.c.(3).(i).(a), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for culture, arts, and tourism, Culture and Arts Program by increasing the appropriation and the condition for Lāna'i Community Association for the Pineapple Festival, in the amount of \$20,000.


