Dear Chair Sugimura:

This letter is written in response to your letter dated July 5, 2024 related to the abovementioned subject.

Pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Section 104-2(a), Chapter 104 is applicable to any construction public works HRS Chapter 201H project exceeding \$500,000 in which a governmental contracting agency is involved. For projects that participate in one or more of HHFDC's financing programs, HHFDC is considered the governmental contracting agency and plays a vital role in ensuring compliance with HRS Chapter 104 through our building loan agreements.

As stipulated in HRS Section 104-3(a), the primary responsibility for submitting weekly certified payrolls to the governmental contracting agency lies with the general contractor. Upon the execution of a HHFDC project agreement, HHFDC provides the developer and/or general contractor with a wage and hour packet containing essential compliance information.

Our duty involves the collection and random scrutiny of the certified payroll and related documentation we receive. In the event that the General Contractor fails to submit payroll in a timely manner or provides payroll that contravenes HRS Chapter 104, loan disbursement will be withheld until the issue is resolved.

Any identified violation is communicated to the project's general contractor and, if necessary, the developer. If the violation is not promptly rectified, it is reported to the Department of Labor Industrial Relations (DLIR) Wage Standards Division for additional review or investigation. This policy also applies to our non-funded projects.
