**Subject: MORATORIUM ON EXPORTING SAND, THE MAUI INLAND SAND RESOURCE
QUANTIFICATION STUDY AND SAND MINING REGULATION (IEM-33)**

Dear Chair Cochran, I am writing in response to your second letter dated August 29, 2017. You have requested from Hawaiian Cement the following information:

-You noted that your current inventory of stockpiled sand is "a little over six years" supply, who supplied Hawaiian Cement with the sand resources in your stockpile?

Due to confidentiality, I am unable to disclose this third party information. I can assure you sand was acquired from several valid projects with excess material, above final grade, which was required to be removed off site.

-Do you know where your current inventory of stockpiled sand came from? Please identify the location(s)?

Again, due to confidentiality, I am unable to disclose this third party information.

-Are you still receiving sand at your plant directly from the source you identified in question 2? If you are receiving sand from other sources please identify the other source location(s).

Hawaiian Cement is currently not receiving any sand. In fact, the sand that is currently stockpiled was received from valid projects back in the 2009-2012 timeframe.

-Is the sand you are currently using to provide cement and / or concrete, from your current stockpile? Do you anticipate increasing your sand stockpile in the future? If so, please indicate from what source.

Hawaiian Cement, Maui Concrete & Aggregate Division, does use Maui Dune sand from our current stockpiles in the production of ready-mix concrete. At this time we do not anticipate increasing our Maui Dune sand stockpiles.
