ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADS APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish additional qualifications for County administrative heads appointed by the Mayor, pursuant to the Section 6-4, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"). Section 6-4 of the Charter authorizes the Council to establish specific qualifications for administrative heads appointed by the Mayor in addition to any set forth in the Charter. More specific qualifications will help identify skilled, experienced individuals to lead the County's departments, strengthen operations, and better serve the public.

SECTION 2. The Maui County Code is amended by adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"Chapter 2.14

SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS

- 2.14.090 Director of housing and human concerns.
- 2.14.100 Director and deputy director of water supply.
- 2.14.110 Director of transportation.
- 2.14.120 Director of environmental management.
- **2.14.010** Additional qualifications. The specific qualifications of administrative heads of departments established in this chapter are in addition to any qualifications set forth in the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended.
- **2.14.020 Managing director.** The managing director, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
- A. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline. A master's degree from an accredited college or university in business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- **2.14.030 Corporation counsel.** The corporation counsel, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
 - A. Three years of civil litigation experience.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- **2.14.040 Prosecuting attorney.** The prosecuting attorney, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
 - A. Three years of criminal litigation experience.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- **2.14.050 Director of finance.** The director of finance, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
- A. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in finance, accounting, economics, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline. A master's degree from an accredited college or university in finance, accounting, economics, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.

- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- C. Certified public accountant (CPA) license or certified public financial officer designation, or both, is highly preferred.
- **2.14.060 Director of public works.** The director of public works, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
- A. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline. A master's degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- **2.14.070 Director of parks and recreation.** The director of parks and recreation, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
- A. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in urban planning, environmental planning, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline. A master's degree from an accredited college or university in urban planning, environmental planning, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- **2.14.080 Planning director.** The planning director, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
- A. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in urban planning, environmental planning, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline. A master's degree in urban planning, environmental planning, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- **2.14.090 Director of housing and human concerns.** The director of housing and human concerns, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:

- A. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in business administration, public administration, sociology, or other relevant discipline. A master's degree in business administration, public administration, sociology, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- **2.14.100 Director and deputy director of water supply.** A. The director of water supply, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
 - 1. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, water resources, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline. A master's degree in engineering, water resources, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.
 - 2. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- B. The deputy director of water supply, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
 - 1. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, water resources, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline.
 - 2. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.
- C. The director or deputy director of water supply shall be a registered engineer.
- **2.14.110 Director of transportation.** The director of transportation, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
- A. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in urban planning, environmental planning, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline. related field. A master's degree in urban planning, environmental planning, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience.

- **2.14.120 Director of environmental management.** The director of environmental management, at a minimum, shall have the following qualifications:
- A. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, environmental science, water resources, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline. A master's degree in engineering, environmental science, water resources, business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, is highly preferred.
- B. Three years of progressively responsible supervisory or management experience in a municipal or government setting, or equivalent experience."

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2019.
