Description: Woven tapestry of the Maui County seal by Alice Kagawa Parrott.

Condition: On-site examination of the artwork shows that it is stable. There is minimal color

fading. Yarns, both warp and weft, still have tensile strength.

Final Treatment:

- 1. Before and after treatment photodocumentation with digital camera,
- 2. The piece was vacuumed front and back to remove dust.
- 3. Weft ends had worked their way to the front were woven back in to present a smoother appearance on the front.
- 4. There was a minor patch of a pale, crumbly accretion on the back and along a portion of one edge. This was removed mechanically with tweezers.
- 5. Weft pile threads that extended beyond the rest of the pile were woven back into the piece to an appropriate length.
- 6. Pile was fluffed and realigned so that original lacunae in the green sections were again visible.


Before treatment


