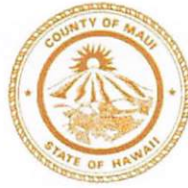



**SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET  
(APPENDIX B, DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, GENERAL  
FUND, PENALTY AND INTEREST – TAT)**

On behalf of the Department of Finance, I am transmitting a proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, APPENDIX B, DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, GENERAL FUND, PENALTY AND INTEREST – TAT.”

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Penalty and Interest – TAT to delete “Up to 20% penalty, Return filed by the due date and the tax is not completely paid within 60 days of the filing due date.”


Although this language is included in Hawai‘i Revised Statutes, Section 231-39(b), it was not included in Ordinance 5273. At this time, the Department
