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At its meeting of October 9, 2024, the DRIP Committee discussed the Kaiāulu o Kūku'ia affordable housing project in West Maui. It was noted that a Memorandum of Understanding ("Sewer MOU") was executed between the County and Hawai'i Housing Finance and Development Corporation ("HHFDC") on April 15, 2020, regarding affordable housing projects in the Leali'i development area of West Maui and their connection to the County sewer system. The Sewer MOU requires HHFDC to build a private wastewater treatment facility for future projects at Leali'i, and further requires that Kaiāulu o Kūku'ia disconnect from the County sewer system and connect to HHFDC's private wastewater treatment facility.

May I please request your written opinion on the following:

- 1. How does the Sewer MOU affect temporary structures within the Villages of Leiali'i with respect to the Ka La'i Ola and Kilohana temporary housing projects?
- 2. Has the requirement to disconnect from the County sewer system and connect to HHFDC's private wastewater system been triggered because of the development of temporary structures in the Villages of Leiali'i area? If so, what is the approximate timeline for the completion of the private wastewater treatment facility and when Kaiāulu o Kūkui'a must disconnect from the County system and connect to HHFDC's private system?
- 3. How does this requirement impact Federal Emergency Management Agency's Kilohana temporary housing project?

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
