SUBJECT: AUTHORIZING SECOND AMENDMENT TO MAUI INVITATIONAL BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT LICENSE AGREEMENT (PRL-42)

Pursuant to your letter dated September 26, 2018, requesting information regarding the second amendment to the Maui Invitational Basketball Tournament license agreement, we are providing the following information:

1. When the first amendment to the License Agreement was considered by the Council's Economic Development, Agriculture, and Recreation ("EDR") Committee in 2012, it was estimated that the event had generated \$153 million for the local economy since its debut in 1984. (See EDR Committee Report 12-62.) Could you please provide the estimated revenue impact of the event for the years since?

We have a request out to gather the information from additional sources, however in the interim, we were able to verify via the official event website that the event generated an "estimated \$13.3 million plus" for the local economy in 2014.

2. When the first amendment was considered, the EDR Committee expressed concern with costs associated with the event, citing utility costs in particular, and it was determined electrical costs for the 2011 event were approximately \$5,640. The Administration revised the proposed resolution to require the Licensee to pay prorated electricity costs, and that provision remains in the proposed Second Amendment.

Please advise of the estimated electrical costs associated with the event in 2017. Please also advise of any other costs incurred by your Department or other

departments involved with hosting the event. Do you recommend any of those costs be negotiated into the terms of the Second Amendment?

The amount we will be assessing to KemperLesnik for prorated electrical costs is \$5,407.02. Other costs are related to annual maintenance of the facility that the Department schedules around the event.
