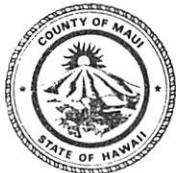

WHEREAS, the estimated value of the 61 pairs of Kaenon sunglasses is approximately \$12,200; and


WHEREAS, the donated 61 pairs of Kaenon sunglasses are intended to provide eye protection for the ocean safety officers employed in the lifeguard division; and
