## COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI

May 9, 2017

THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI, STATE OF HAWAII, WAS HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, KALANA O MAUI BUILDING, WAILUKU, HAWAII, ON TUESDAY, MAY 9, 2017, BEGINNING AT 9:01 A.M., WITH CHAIR MICHAEL B. WHITE PRESIDING.

CHAIR WHITE: This special meeting of the County Council of Maui will please come to order.

Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

### ROLL CALL

COUNTY CLERK DENNIS A. MATEO: Mr. Chair, seven Members present, two excused. A quorum is present to conduct the business of the Council.

CHAIR WHITE: Thank you.

Lanai Office, please identify yourself and introduce your first testifier.

Molokai Office, please identify yourself and introduce your first testifier.

MS. ELLA ALCON: Good morning, Chair. This is Ella Alcon on Molokai, and there is no one here waiting to testify.

COUNCILMEMBER HOKAMA: Chairman, these various bills went through your Committee, as well as first reading by the Council. All bills have been approved first reading by unanimous vote.

Just some highlights for Bill 50. This allows the celebration of our national park, Haleakala, to have a special license plate, as well as Volcanoes National Park.

Number two makes a specific requirement, spending Economic Development Funds for Molokai.

Bills 52 through 54, of course, is a 20 plus million-dollar bond authorization to start the South Maui gymnasium project, which is about for me, 20 years old. But, we're going to get it done.

And finally, Chairman, Bill 55 is, which is the adjustment that Fire Department needs to complete their fiscal year. Thank you.

CHAIR WHITE: Thank you.

Members, any further discussion on these items? Seeing none, all those in favor please signify by saying "aye".
