SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET (DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM AND PARKS PROGRAM)

On behalf of the Department of Parks and Recreation, I am transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM AND PARKS PROGRAM."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to decrease the appropriation for Department of Parks and Recreation, Administration Program, Category A – Salaries by \$127,164, and to decrease the equivalent personnel from 45.0 to 43.0, and to increase the appropriation for the Department of Parks and Recreation, Parks Program, Category A – Salaries, by \$127,164, and to increase the equivalent personnel from 82.9 to 84.9.

The Department of Parks and Recreation has received approval for a reorganization to move two Planner positions, one Planner V and one Planner VI,

from the Administration Program, Parks Administration to the Parks Program, Planning and Development. The requested amendment will cover the salaries for these two positions for the remainder of Fiscal Year 2025.
