A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES;
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS,
COUNTYWIDE, GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, BOND FUND,
DPW HIGHWAY DIVISION COUNTYWIDE BASEYARD FACILITIES;
TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS;
TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5392, Bill No. 69, CD1, FD2 (2022), "Fiscal Year 2023 Budget", is hereby amended as it pertains to Section 2, Estimated Revenues, by increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond in the amount of \$1,207,000; and by increasing the Total Estimated Revenues in the amount of \$1,207,000, to read as follows:

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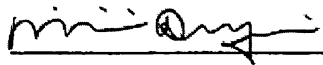

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SECTION 5. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored.

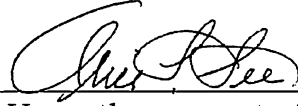

1. Section 2, Estimated Revenues, by increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond in the amount of \$1,207,000; and by increasing the Total Estimated Revenues in the amount of \$1,207,000;
2. Section 4.G.1.a.(2).(ii), Department of Public Works, Countywide, Government Facilities, Bond Fund by increasing the appropriation for the DPW Highway Division Countywide Baseyard Facilities Program by \$1,207,000;
3. Total Capital Improvement Project Appropriations to reflect an increase of \$1,207,000; and
4. Total Appropriations (Operating and Capital Improvement Projects) to reflect an increase of \$1,207,000.
