AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY, FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET

WHEREAS, Section 9-10(2) of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"), provides that, upon written request of the Mayor, part or all of any unencumbered appropriation balance may be transferred within a department by resolution or from one department to another by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions in Ordinance No. 4988, Bill No. 36 (2019), Draft 1, as amended, ("Fiscal Year 2020 Budget"), states that, unless otherwise provided, appropriations for each program may be disbursed for the following categories of use: (a) salaries, premium pay, or reallocation pay, (b) operations or services, and (c) equipment; provided the disbursement is within the program and category of use for which it was appropriated; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.B.14. of the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, relating to the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, sets forth appropriations for the Administration Program and General Prosecution Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-10(2) of the Charter, Mayor Michael P. Victorino has submitted a written request to transfer an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$15,000 from the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney, General Prosecution Program, Category A (salaries), to the Department of the

Prosecuting Attorney, Administration Program, Category A (salaries), in order to disburse \$15,000 for salaries relating to an internship program; and to transfer an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$50,000 from the General Prosecution Program, Category A (salaries) to the General Prosecution Program, Category B (operations), in order to disburse \$50,000 for travel and travel related costs for Molokai and Lanai district and family court and cold case investigations; now, therefore.
