Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on January 23, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 18-8, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY, LANAI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, LANAI FIRE STATION IMPROVEMENTS; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2018 Budget by 1) increasing Carryover/Savings from the General Fund by \$10,000; 2) amending Section 4.C.2.a(1)(i), by increasing the appropriation by \$10,000 under the Department of Fire and Public Safety ("Department"), Lanai Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, General Fund, for the Lanai Fire Station Improvements; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF FIRE AND PUBLIC SAFETY, LANAI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, LANAI FIRE STATION IMPROVEMENTS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2018 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by increasing the appropriation for the Lanai Fire Station Improvements by \$10,000 under the Department, Lanai Community Plan Area, and revising the project description to include design work.

3. A Certification of Additional Revenues for FY 2018, dated December 14, 2017, for \$10,000 in Carryover/Savings from the General Fund.

Your Committee notes the FY 2018 Budget appropriated \$100,000 for the Lanai Fire Station Improvements. The funds will be used for land acquisition for the Lanai Fire Station apparatus bay addition to store specialized Department equipment.

The Fire Chief said the proposed amendment to the project description will allow for design of the project once the land is acquired. The Department's plan is to design two apparatus bays to shelter and contain all equipment currently without a proper storage facility. He said the Department is acquiring the parcel directly behind the Lanai Fire Station for its expansion project.

A representative from the Department said discussions to acquire the land are ongoing with Pulama Lanai and he does not foresee any obstacles in the project moving forward. He was unable to provide a timeline for the project and land acquisition.

The representative said the property will have to be subdivided before Pulama Lanai can convey the parcel to the County. The Department will begin project design upon acceptance of the parcel.

Your Committee noted that unless there are major changes to the bypass road on the south side of Lanai City, the additional bays would face the bypass road for ease of accessibility and response to alarms.

A Deputy Corporation Counsel said Pulama Lanai intends to donate the parcel to the County. He said the County will be responsible for any costs related to subdivision of the land.

Your Committee voted 6-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Carroll, Crivello, Guzman, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee members Atay, Cochran, and King were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed bill as noted in item 1 above, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the FY 2018 Budget.
