The Makila Farms Project is offering 1 bedroom homes up to 4 Bedroom Homes, I would need a one or two bedroom home. I know Greg Brown and Brown Development and I have heard and I understand the issues of the people in the valley and Launiupoko and I respect them. I have done my research and all those issues are resolved such as water, fire, access, Run off, and septic's. Greg Brown will be drilling his own agriculture well, he has more fire hydrants than needed, multiple evacuation routes, he will also be catching the brown water that goes into the ocean, and they won't be using regular septic tanks.
