

AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT OF COUNTY OF MAUI V. RICK MARKHAM, ET AL., CIVIL NO. 17-1-0384 (2)

WHEREAS, the COUNTY OF MAUI filed a lawsuit in the Second Circuit in the State of Hawaii on September 11, 2017, Case No. 17-1-0384 (2), against Rick Markham, North Shore Maui, LLC, et al., claiming zoning code violations of his property located at 115 Hana Highway, Paia, Maui, Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, the County of Maui, to avoid incurring expenses and the uncertainty of a judicial determination of the parties' respective rights and liabilities, will attempt to reach a resolution of this case by way of a negotiated settlement or Offer of Judgment; and

WHEREAS, the Department of the Corporation Counsel has requested authority to settle this case under the terms set forth in an executive meeting before the Governance, Ethics, and Transparency Committee on June 23, 2020; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed the facts and circumstances regarding this case and being advised of attempts to reach resolution of this case by way of a negotiated settlement or Offer of Judgment by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, the Council wishes to authorize the settlement; now, therefore,
