Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on October 2, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 18-327, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY, HANA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, WATER SUPPLY, KAUPU WATER TANK IMPROVEMENTS; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)" ("Budget bill").

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2019 Budget by 1) increasing Carryover/Savings from the Water Fund in the amount of \$450,000; 2) amending Section 4.J., Department of Water Supply ("Department"), by adding Hana Community Plan Area, Water Supply, Water Fund - Unrestricted, Kaupo Water Tank Improvements ("Project"), for \$450,000; and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY, HANA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, KAUPU WATER TANK IMPROVEMENTS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2019 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, for the Department, by adding Hana Community Plan Area and the Project for \$450,000 and a project description.

3. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2019 dated September 11, 2018, for \$450,000 in Carryover/Savings from the Water Fund.

The Budget Director said the recognition of \$450,000 in Carryover/Savings from the Water Fund is in excess of the amount already recognized in the FY 2019 Budget.

The Director of Water Supply said the Project includes the construction of a 100,000-gallon water tank and removal of the existing 50,000-gallon tank. She said the replacement of the existing tank is necessary because of its deteriorated condition. The Director said the increase in storage capacity will greatly assist the residents of Kaupo as well as Kaupo Ranch, Ltd. ("Ranch").

The Director said the Project will allow non-potable water to be provided to the 21 customers currently on the system. She noted because non-potable water is provided through the system, each customer was required to sign a legal agreement with the Department acknowledging the water meter they are receiving is providing non-potable water. She said if the water is not used for non-potable purposes, the water meter will be removed. The Director said the long-range goal is to convert from non-potable water to potable water.

A representative from the Ranch said in 2010 they installed a deep water well at a cost in excess of \$700,000. He said there are currently 18 tanks connected to the well that are being maintained by the Ranch. The cost to the Ranch to maintain the water system is \$82,000 annually.

The Director said an agreement was executed in 1941 between the County and the Ranch relating to the water system and water availability

to Kaupo residents. She said the Department is currently updating the agreement to re-establish the responsibilities of both parties.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee members Carroll and Cochran were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed Budget bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the FY 2019 Budget.

Your Budget and Finance Committee RECOMMENDS the following:


