THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI,
OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM,
GRANTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT
AND TECHNOLOGY, LĀHAINĀ TOWN ACTION COMMITTEE;
GRANTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR CULTURE, ARTS,
AND TOURISM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5528, Bill No. 22, CD1, FD2 (2023), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2024 Budget", Section 3.B.10.c.(2).(xi), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, Lāhainā Town Action Committee, is amended to increase the appropriation by \$10,000, to read as follows:


