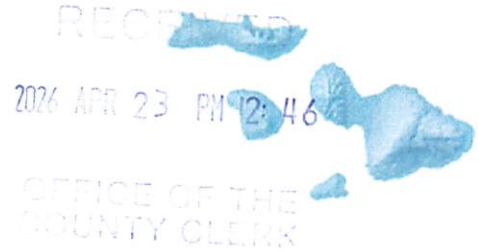

On behalf of the Department of Management, I am transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 5818 (2025), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Ordinance No. 5818, to add a new appropriation under the Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area for Hālau of 'Ōiwi Arts in the amount of \$4,000,000, and to increase the total by the same amount.
