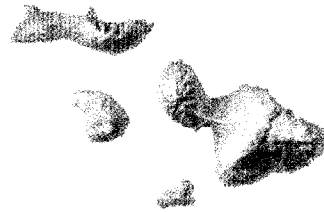
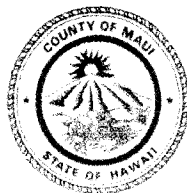



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2019 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX A, PART I,
GRANTS AND RESTRICTED USE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF GRANTS AND
RESTRICTED USE REVENUES BY DEPARTMENTS AND PROGRAMS,
DEPARTMENT OF POLICE
(PAUL COVERDELL FORENSIC SCIENCES IMPROVEMENT ACT)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4861, Bill No. 57 (2018), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2019 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2019, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Police, by increasing the appropriation for the Paul Coverdell Forensic Sciences Improvement Act by \$32,472, to read as follows:

"9. Department of Police

a. Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Program	15,000
b. Department of Health (DOH) Grants	416,262
(1) Provided, that disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 5.0 LTA equivalent personnel.	
c. Department of Transportation Highway Safety Grants	1,199,676
d. Domestic Cannabis Eradication/Suppression Program - Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA)	51,000
e. Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants	96,000
f. Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA)	109,000
g. Hawaii Community Foundation Grant	1,000
h. High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA)	130,000
i. Office of Youth Services Grants	175,000
j. Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force (OCDETF) Program	1,000
k. Paul Coverdell Forensic Sciences Improvement Act	[5,000] <u>37,472</u>
l. State E911 Wireless Commission	2,000,000
m. State Farm Neighborhood Assist Grant	1,000

- n. State and Federal Assets Forfeiture Program 100,000
 - (1) Provided, that a quarterly report be submitted to Council on the use of forfeiture funds.

- o. Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) - State Attorney General 53,000"

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
