'BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5099, Bill No. 64 (2020), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2021 Budget," Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2021, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Transportation, by adding two new grants entitled "Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA) Section 5307 Urbanized Area Apportionments" in the amount of \$2,841,510, and "Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA) Section 5311 Rural Area Apportionments" in the amount of \$4,000,135, to read as follows:

"12. Department of Transportation

a. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and Other Transportation Program Grants for Maui Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) (1) Disbursement for salaries and premium pay is limited to 2.0 LTA equivalent personnel.	625,000
b. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP)	20,000
c. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section Rural/5339 Formula Funds Program	500,000
d. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section Small Urban/5339 Formula Funds Program	700,000
e. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 Non-Urbanized Area Formula Program	1,200,000
f. Transportation Program Grants	4,500,000
g. Urbanized Area Formula Program 5307	2,500,000

h. Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 2,841,510
(CRRSAA) Section 5307 Urbanized Area Apportionments

i. Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 4,000,135"
(CRRSAA) Section 5311 Rural Area Apportionments


