Chair and Members:

Your Planning and Sustainable Land Use Committee, having met on February 13, 2019, makes reference to County Communications 18-75 and 19-65, both from the Planning Director, respectively transmitting the 2017 and 2018 status reports on the implementation of eight of the nine community plans.

Your Committee notes the Kaho`olawe Community Plan was excluded from the status reports because its implementation is within the jurisdiction of the Kaho`olawe Island Reserve Commission.

Your Committee notes the Council's Planning Committee (2017-2019 Council term) met on the 2017 status report on March 1, 2018, and December 6, 2018.

The Planning Program Administrator, Plan Implementation Division, Department of Planning, told your Committee the status reports categorize each community plan action item as either "completed," "in progress," or "not begun." Some items may always remain "in progress" because they will be continuously implemented.

The Planning Program Administrator stated the community plans include 711 action items, 168 of which have been completed.

She also said the action items in the 2018 status report pertaining to Moloka`i are from the 2001 Moloka`i Community Plan. The action items in the current Moloka`i Island Community Plan, established by Ordinance 4920 (2018), will be included in the 2019 status report.


The status reports are arranged based on each implementing agency's responsibilities. Your Committee suggested a status report with action items listed by community plan would make it easier to review the status of each community plan's action items. Your Committee also expressed a desire for community plans to prioritize action items.

Your Committee commends the Department of Planning for monitoring and reporting on the status of community plan action items.

Your Committee voted 4-0 to recommend filing of County Communication 18-75. Committee Chair Paltin, Vice-Chair Sinenci, and members King and Rawlins-Fernandez voted "aye." Committee members Lee, Molina, and Sugimura were excused.
