Re: Kanaha Beach Park -Illegal overnight parking along Amala Place

Maui Green & Beautiful (formerly Maui Outdoor Circle), has met with you before regarding our concerns about the Kanaha area. It seems this living treasure is constantly assaulted in so many different ways over the few years that we have been involved in trying to find a solution that would preserve this significant eco-system from harm for future generations.

We need your assistance on a recent problem that has been brought to our attention by long time Kanaha Beach Park volunteer Mike Perry. We have nothing but respect for Mike Perry.

The following are our concerns:

- Parking is allowed only on Amala Place from 6am until 8pm as stated on the road signs but in the last several weeks, there has been anywhere from 10 to 25 cars parked overnight on Amala Place, which is illegal. Attach are photos of the road side cars.
- The cars are parked there but the occupants' camp on the other side of the fence, damaging native plants and leaving rubbish.
- Why are the cars allowed there along with the illegal camping along the road and over the fenced area?
- There is camping going on in other areas of the park which is prohibited and this does not include fishermen.

We all know about the homeless problem on our island and in our State but Kanaha is the only beach park in Kahului and in the State that contains so many native plants, wetlands, and wildlife. This area is a living classroom, a family beach, a place to enjoy water sports and fishing, walking on the beach and legal camping in the camp grounds.

Maui Green & Beautiful would like to meet with you and discuss finding a permanent solution in preserving this Community treasure.


