SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4456, Bill No. 65 (2017), Draft 1, "Fiscal Year 2018 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grant Revenue - Schedule of Grants by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2018, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Department of Police, by increasing the appropriation for Office of Youth Services Grants by \$59,682, to read as follows:
