Our family has rented our Maui homes for short term rentals since 1962.

We have complied with all Maui county regulations and paid our taxes timely.

Where needed, we have applied for and received permits for vacation rentals.

We write to ask you to vote against LU-7 and LU-40.

Proposed LU-7 and LU-40 seem unfair and contradictory to the process and promise of

permits received at homeowner cost and efforts and country covenants. Permits should be an earned property right transferable by inheritance, gift or sale, protected by due process

as long as the new owner agrees to abide by Maui County regulations, terms and conditions, including payment of fees. As presented to us, the proposed bills do not hold to this standard of fairness. Therefore we ask you to vote them down.
