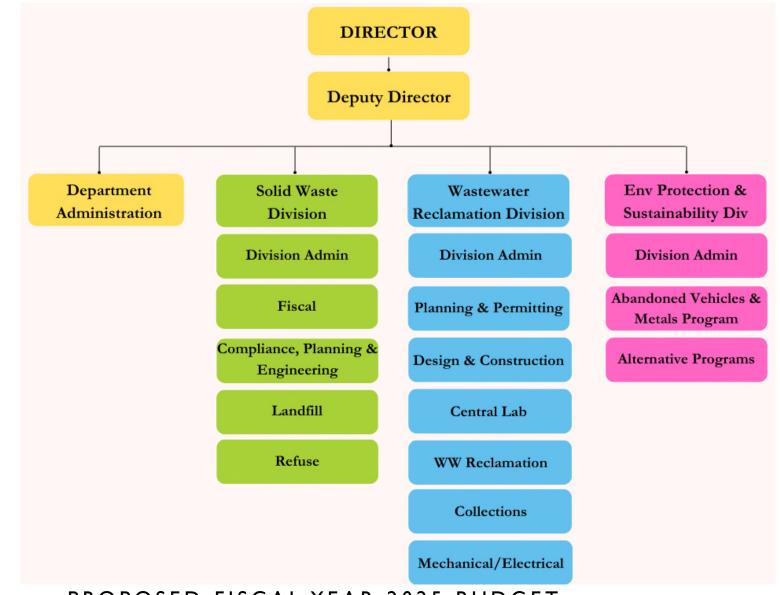

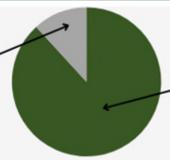

DEM Impacts Due to Wildfires

Wastewater Reclamation Division:

Affected 4 Pump Stations (Temp. Fixes Done to Currently Operate)

PS#5 & PS#6 Major Damages - Require Complete Rebuild PS#3 & PS#4 Minor Damages - Rehab.

• Compromised collection system (Lots of I&I)

CCTV of Approx. 90,000 l.f. Recently Completed; Approx. 9,000 l.f. Deferred Contract Repairs Based on Final Damage Assessment Report

Stabilize Plant Process (Re-establish process)

Work with process experts
Prevent non-wastewater dumps

• 847 Refuse Carts Destroyed (Current Replacement Cost = \$84.76/cart)

EP&S Division:

Recycling Drop Box & HI-5 Center Destroyed (Currently Working w/ Vendor on a new West Maui Location)

Capital Improvement Program

Wastewater Reclamation Division:

FY2024 = \$36.0M

FY2025 = \$40.7M

Solid Waste Division:

FY2024 = \$7.25M

Wastewater Reclamation Division

Capital Improvement Program: FY2025 - \$40.7M

Project Types:

- Does it Work / Is it Safe?
 1 project budgeted \$0.5M
- Is it Reliable (end of useful life)? 14 projects budgeted \$27.7M
- Expansion of Service 2 project budgeted \$7.0M
- Recycled Water Projects 4 projects budgeted \$2.8M

Solid Waste Division

Capital Improvement Program: FY2025 - \$4.60M

DEM Revolving Funds

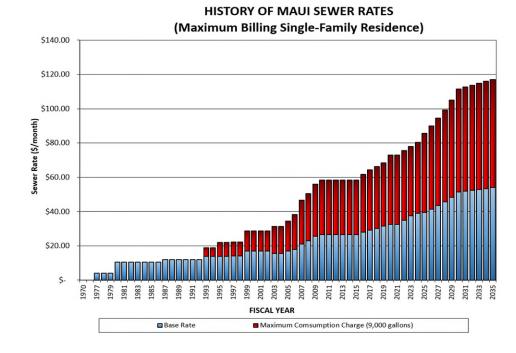
