**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026
BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI,
DEPARTMENT OF POLICE,
ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM AND TECHNICAL AND SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAM**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5816, Bill No. 41, CD1, FD2 (2025), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2026 Budget", Section 3.B.17.a.(1), Department of Police, Administration Program, is amended to increase the appropriation for Category A – Salaries, in the amount of \$57,192 and increase the equivalent personnel from 32.0 to 33.0, and to adjust the totals accordingly, to read as follows:



Fiscal Year 2026 Budget Section 3.B.17.d.(1), Department of Police, Technical and Support Services Program, is amended to decrease the appropriation for Category A – Salaries, by \$57,192, and to decrease the equivalent personnel from 130.0 to 129.0, and to adjust the totals accordingly, to read as follows:
