May I please request status updates on the following line items and conditions listed in the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget, for the Office of the Mayor, Administration Program:

- Environmental Protection: Up to \$600,000 must be used for watershed management planning and implementation by Maui Environmental Consulting, Inc. or Central Maui Soil and Water Conservation District.
- Environmental Protection: Up to \$103,240 must be used for the Maui Nui Seabird Recovery Project.
- Green Building and Resilient Housing: \$100,000.
- Maui Invasive Species Committee for eradication of coqui frog, little fire ants, miconia, and other invasive species: \$2,800,000.


