WHEREAS, by correspondence dated March 20, 2019, Mayor Michael P. Victorino notified the Council he nominated Stacy Otomo to the Public Works Commission for the County of Maui for a term expiring on March 31, 2024, to fill a vacancy replacing Brooks Aoki, pursuant to Sections 2.40.220 and Chapter 2.98, Maui County Code, and Section 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, (“Charter”); and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2, requires the Mayor’s nominee to be approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2(17), requires the Council to approve or disapprove the nomination within sixty days after the Mayor submits the name of the nominee to the Council because of the death, resignation, or removal of a member; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it approves the appointment of Stacy Otomo to serve on the Public Works Commission for the County of Maui for a term expiring March 31, 2024;
2. That the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to Stacy Otomo for his willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in County government; and
