FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS SUBJECT: TO THE MAUI COUNTY CHARTER (PROJECT NO. 24-02)

Section 3-9.2(5) of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"), states the Office of the County Auditor shall assess the fiscal impact of any proposed amendment to the Charter

The 2024 General Election ballot for Maui County voters will contain three (3) proposed amendments to the Charter. The attached "Exhibit 1" is my Office's independent evaluation of the potential fiscal impacts of each of the proposed Charter amendments, listing the additional annual estimated costs for each proposal.

This evaluation is not an audit and purposely does not include conclusions and explanatory language within Exhibit 1 in order to avoid any perception that my Office is advocating for or against any of the proposed Charter amendments. That format—while less than ideal—is intended to avoid the loss of public trust, the possible violation of campaign finance laws, and the use of government funds to advocate for or against a ballot initiative.

Fiscal Impact Analysis of Proposed Charter Amendments to the Maui County Charter on the 2024 General Election Ballot

Charter Amendment Proposals	Additional Estimated Annual Fiscal Impact
Shall the Charter be amended to require the Salary Commission to determine 'salaries' instead of 'compensation' for elected officials and appointed directors and deputy directors to maintain consistency with the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i and remove fiscal barriers to create equity through benefits such as reimbursement of travel costs?	<\$25,000
Shall the Charter be amended, effective July 1, 2025, to authorize the Board of Ethics of the County of Maui to hire independent staff?	\$1,100,000
Shall the Charter be amended, effective July 1, 2025, to minimize the risk of vacancies on boards and commissions generally, and specifically with regard to dedicated seats for members residing in less populous areas, by allowing the appointment of members of boards and commissions for two consecutive full terms or ten consecutive years, whichever is greater?	<\$25,000
