APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE URBAN DESIGN REVIEW BOARD FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated January 29, 2025, Mayor Richard T. Bissen, Jr. notified the Council he nominated the person listed in Exhibit "A," as attached, as a member to the Urban Design Review Board for the County of Maui, in accordance with Sections 2.26.030 and 2.40.100, Maui County Code, and Section 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"); and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2 requires the Mayor's nominees to be approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2(17) requires the Council to approve or disapprove the Mayor's nomination within thirty days after the Mayor submits the names of the nominees to the Council and shall immediately so notify the Mayor of its action; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it approves the appointment of the person listed in Exhibit "B," as attached, as a member to the Urban Design Review Board for the terms specified;
2. That it disapproves the appointment of the person listed in Exhibit "C," as attached, as a member to the Urban Design Review Board as nominated by the Mayor;
3. That the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to the appointed member for their willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in County government; and
4. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor and the Managing Director.


