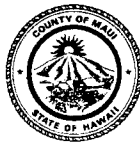


1. Provide information on how far away from the inundation zone the War Memorial Gym building is located, including an overlay that shows the location of the gym in relation to projected sea-level rise.

4. The Committee was made aware that there is currently one water-bottle-fill station located at the War Memorial Complex. Please provide information on whether additional bottle-fill stations are included in the proposed renovations.
