Maui County's Emergency Rental Assistance Program is now open!

- Up to \$2,500 a month in rent and utility arrears
- Up to \$2,000 for future rent payments
- Up to \$500 a month for future electric, water and sewer, and gas bills

- Proof of Hardship

Emergency Rental and Utility Update

- As of earlier this week, the Emergency Rental and Utility Assistance Program has helped more than 287 households make overdue rent payments, totaling in excess of \$1,242,545
- More funding is available; Residents who think they might be eligible are encouraged to get more information and apply
- The federal funds are for residents impacted financially by the COVID-19 pandemic
- Most of the applications for assistance have come from:
 - South Maui (191 applications)
 - West Maui (171 applications)
 - Central Maui (246 –Kahului and Wailuku applications)
