FY 2018

Subject to the availability of funds, the Executive Office on Aging (EOA) intends to award the County of Maui, Maui County Office of Aging, state general funds for the fiscal year 2018.

 Funds in the amount of \$678,778.00 are for the provision of Kupuna Care services and supports to adults 60 years of age and older in Maui County. Please be advised that funding levels are based on a funding formula EOA utilizes to disperse state funds between all four counties in Hawaii.

 Additionally, funds in the amount of \$26,492.00 are for the provision of Elder Abuse services and support to older adults, 60 years of age or older in Maui County, and who are at imminent risk of abuse and neglect.

These funds are subject to the allotments to be made by the Director of Finance, State of Hawaii pursuant to Chapter 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
