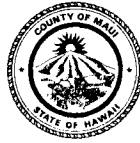

To assist the Committee in its discussion, may I respectfully request that you provide a representative from the Office of Hawaiian Affairs to attend the meeting to address community concerns relating to historic, cultural, and archaeological preservation burial sites within the historic Mo`omuku Ahupua`a area in Makena, Maui, Hawaii, specifically including lands identified for real property tax purposes as tax map keys (2) 2-1-005:026, and (2) 2-1-005:129 through (2) 2-1-005:139.

May I also request you identify the concerns which prompted the Office of Hawaiian Affairs' request for a stop work order, for permits G2015/0117, G2016/0205, and G2017/0419, for tax map key (2) 2-1-005:035 and provide any related documentation or correspondence.
