FOR MEMBERS THAT ARE PARTICIPATING FROM REMOTE SITES IF YOU COULD PLEASE LET US KNOW IF ANYONE, EXCEPT FOR MINORS, ARE PRESENT WITH YOU. COUNCIL MEMBER PRO TEMPORE TASHA KAMA. ALOHA KAKAHIAKA AND HALOHA, CHAIR LEE AND EVERYONE ELSE THIS MORNING.\r\n\r\n>> THANK YOU. >> VICE-CHAIR YUKI LEI SUGIMURA. >> GOOD MORNING EVERYBODY. GOOD MORNING EVERYONE. CHAIR, MEMBERS, CLERKS, STAFF AND VIEWERS. AS I WAS PLANNING ON WHAT I WAS GOING TO SAY TODAY, I DECIDED I WAS NOT GOING TO TALK ABOUT THE BUDGET THAT WE ALL WORKED SO HARD ON. BUT BEFORE I DO THAT, BECAUSE I'M SO TIRED OF HEARING THE WORD "BUDGET," UNTIL THE FIRST READING AN THE 21ST TO TAKE A BREAK FROM THE WORD "BUDGET." MOVING ON TO ACKNOWLEDGE AS WE AS A BODY PRIORITIZED HOUSING IN WEST MAUI AND THANK FOR THE SUPPORT YOU SHOWED MY COMMUNITY AND I'M HAPPY AND RELIEVED WE WERE ABLE TO LOWER HOMEOWNER PROPERTY TAXES. OKAY.\r\n\r\nLET'S MOVE ON. WE HAVE SIX WOMEN ON THIS COUNCIL, SHANE, TOM, WHO IS NOT HERE AND GABE, ONLINE, YOU GUYS ARE COOL AND DON'T GET BE WRONG, BUT TO CELEBRATE THE FACT WE HAVE A MAJORITY WOMEN COUNCIL AND THIS IS LEAPS AND BOUNDS FROM A FEW DECADES AGO FOR BUDGET AND FINANCES THIS YEAR MARKS THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE EQUAL OPPORTUNITY ACT OF 1974 AND BEFORE THEN WOMEN NEEDED THEIR HUSBANDS OR FATHERS OR BROTHERS TO COSIGN A LOAN, LIKE A MORTGAGE OR CREDIT CARD. THIS WAS MONUMENTAL IN HAVING AUTONOMY IN OUR LIVE. PATSY MINK, PROUD PA'IA GRADUATE IS COMMEMORATED ON A QUARTER. AS MANY OF YOU MIGHT KNOW, I'M VERY CLOSE TO BOTH OF MY GRANDMOTHERS. YOU MIGHT REMEMBER THEY WALKED ME DOWN THE CHAMBER AISLE ON INAUGURATION DAY. WHILE I'M EXTREMELY GRATEFUL FOR THE PATSY MINX AND FOR THOSE WHO HELPED TO SHAPE THE CULTURE OF SOCIETY FOR WOMEN TODAY, THE PARADIGM SHIFT FOR WOMEN TO LITERALLY START IN HOUSE, FOR INSTANCE MY GRANDMOTHER USED TO PIN UP HER SKIRT TO MAKE MAKESHIFT PANTS KNOWING SHE WOULD GET LICKINGS IN SCHOOL FROM HER TEACHERS AND TODAY I WEAR PANTS WITHOUT A SECOND THOUGHT. THAT IS WHY I'M WEARING PANTS TODAY.\r\nIF YOU KNOW -- IF YOU DON'T KNOW, YOU HAVE TO ASK SOMEBODY -- NONETHELESS, SHE TELLS ME THINGS THAT YOUR HUSBAND

ALLOWS YOU DO WHAT YOU DO, WHICH I REPLY, GRANDMA, MY HUSBAND IS SO LUCKY I ALLOWED HIM TO MARRY ME. TO BE FAIR, BECAUSE I PRACTICED THIS SPEECH WITH HIM YESTERDAY, HE IS LUCKY AND I'M LUCKY TOO. HE IS THE KINDEST SOUL I HAVE EVER MET. A FEW YEARS AGO MY VERY LUCKY HUSBAND AND I WHILE IN PORTLAND FOUND A FEMINIST BOOKSTORE WHERE I BROUGHT RUTH BADER GINSBERG T-SHIRT AND IT'S A SHORT BOOK. IT'S ENTITLED "MY FIRST BOOK OF FEMINISM FOR BOYS." RESPECT YOUR MOM IS THE RIGHT THING TO DO, BECAUSE SHE IS A PERSON, THE ONE WHO MADE YOU. HE IS OKAY TO CRY, TO LOVE, AND BE SAD, BOYS CAN FEEL MORE THAN JUST HAPPY OR MAD. SOME DAY WHEN YOU ARE GROWN, YOU WILL BE BIG AND STRONG, IF YOU THINK STRENGTH MEANS MUSCLES, YOUR THINKING IS WRONG.\r\n\r\nFLEX YOUR BRAINPOWERS SPEAK UP FOR WHAT IS RIGHT AND KNOW THAT WOMEN ARE STRONG AND WIN YOUR WORDS TO WIN FIGHTS. PLAY DRESS UP OR WHATEVER ELSE, MAKE ART, PLAY WITH TOYS, GAMES ARE NOT MADE FOR JUST LITTLE GIRLS OR LITTLE BOYS. BE FRIENDS WITH GIRLS, PLAY WITH KIDS WHO ARE KIND, YOU WILL LEARN MORE FROM FRIENDS WHO ARE DIFFERENT YOU WILL FIND. WHEN YOU EAT, CLEAR YOUR DISHES, WHEN YOU PEE, LIFT THE SEAT. CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF, THINK OF OTHERS, BE NEAT. AS SOON AS YOU ARE ABLE YOU COULD DO SIMPLE CHORES MAKE YOUR BED, TAKE OUT THE TRASH, FOLD LAUNDRY AND THERE AREN'T GIRL JOBS OR BOY JOBS. DO WHAT YOU DO, IT'S NOBODY'S JOB TO CLEAN UP AFTER YOU.\r\n\r\nIF YOU LEARN TO WORK HARD, YOU CAN DO SOMETHING COOL, FIGHT FIRES, BAKE CAKES, FLY SPACESHIP, TEACH SCHOOL, FIND A JOB YOU WILL LOVE, HEADING OFF TO EACH DAY, KNOW THAT WOMEN THAT YOU WORK WITH MUST EARN EQUAL PAY. IF A GIRL SAYS DON'T TOUCH ME, OR ASKS YOU TO GO, YOU MUST LEAVE HER ALONE, BECAUSE NO MEANS NO. A JUST AND FAIR WORLD IS WITHIN ALL OF OUR SIGHTS, AND IF YOU SPREAD THE WORD, WOMEN'S RIGHTS ARE HUMAN RIGHTS. BE RESPECTFUL, BE KIND, BE FAIR AND HERE IS WHY: BECAUSE WOMEN ARE HOLDING UP HALF OF THE SKY. THAT IS ALL FOR ME, CHAIR. CLERK >> CHAIR, MOVING ON TO ORDINANCES FOR SECOND AND FINAL READING BEFORE YOU IS BILL 72 (2024) A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3.35 AND SECTION 16.28.010 MAUI COUNTY CODE RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING REVOLVING FUNDS. >> VICE-CHAIR SUGIMURA. >> THANK YOU, CHAIR. I MOVE TO PASS BILL 72 (2024) ON SECOND AND FINAL READING. >> MOVED BY VICE-CHAIR SUGIMURA AND SECONDED BY PRO TEM KAMA TO PASS THE BILL ON SECOND AND FINAL READING. DISCUSSION. SPEAKING ON RESOLUTION 24-79, NO COINCIDENCE IN THE NUMBERS AND THE OTHER ONE WAS ALSO 79, AND 79 WAS THE REAWAKENING OF THE HAWAIIAN KINGDOM AND NOW IT'S 2024. SO IN RELEVATION TO THIS RESOLUTION HERE WITH THE HOUSING AND HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. I WOULD ASK THEM TO DO NOT USE THE DEROGATORY FORM OF THE H WORD TO DESCRIBE THE PEOPLE OF HAWAI'I, QUEEN LILI'UOKALANI WOULD NOT LIKE THAT. >> ANY MORE DISCUSSION? MADAM CLERK. >> LAST CALL FOR ANY TESTIFIERS ON UNFINISHED BUSINESS, BILL 24-79. NO ONE IS SIGNED UP AND THERE'S NO ONE RAISING THEIR HAND.\r\nSO I WILL COUNT DOWN, 3, 2, 1. CHAIR, THERE'S NO ONE TO TESTIFY ON UNFINISHED BUSINESS. >> MEMBERS, ANY OBJECTIONS TO CLOSING PUBLIC TESTIMONY AND ACCEPTING WRITTEN TESTIMONY ON THE BILL IN SECTION N? >> NO OBJECTIONS. >> OKAY. MS. CLERK. >> CHAIR, BEFORE YOU IS BILL 24-79 AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR A GRANT UNDER THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM. >> VICE-CHAIR SUGIMURA.\r\n\r\n>> THANK YOU. I MOVE TO WAIVE THE REQUIREMENT OF COMMITTEE REFERRAL AND REPORT UNDER RULE 7G OF THE RULES OF THE COUNCIL AS IT RELATES TO RESOLUTION 24-79. >> SECOND. >> MOVED BY MEMBER VICE-CHAIR SUGIMURA AND SECONDED BY PRO TEM KAMA TO PASS THE BILL ON SECOND AND FINAL MEETING DISCUSSION. >> THIS RESOLUTION AUTHORIZE THE ADMINISTRATION TO APPLY FOR CDBG FUNDING. WE ADOPTED A SIMILAR MEASURE, WE ADOPTED A SIMILAR MEASURE EVERY YEAR TO COUNTY CAN ACCESS THAT FUNDING APPROVING THE WAIVER WILL ALLOW US TO TAKE ACTION TODAY. THANK YOU. >> ANY MORE DISCUSSION? CLERK. >> THANK YOU, MADAM CHAIR.\r\n\r\nTHAT WAS THE WAIVER. >> WE WAIVED THE RULE OF THE COUNCIL. >> SO NOW ADOPTION. >> YES, I MOVE TO ADOPT RESOLUTION 24-79. >> SECOND. >> OKAY. YOU MOVE TO ADOPT RESOLUTION 24-79. ANY MORE DISCUSSION ON THIS MATTER? IT WAS SECONDED BY PRO TEM KAMA.\r\n\r\n>> YES. >> VICE-CHAIR SUGIMURA. >> THIS RESOLUTION AUTHORIZES THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR A GRANT OF \$1,829,334 TO AID THE DEPARTMENT OF TWO WILDFIRE RECOVERY PROJECTS. NO. 1. AFFORDABLE RENTAL HOUSING NA HALE KUPUNA AND THE PROJECT RESILIENCE CENTER ACQUISITION. WHEN WE TOOK UP THE OFFICE THE MAYOR DURING OUR FISCAL YEAR BUDGET DELIBERATIONS ON APRIL 10TH, THEY NOTED IN THE PRESENTATION THE TWO PROJECTS UNDER BFED ONE GRANICUS 123 AND THE OFFICE HAS INDICATED THAT THEY HAVE NOT RECEIVED THE NOTIFICATION OF GRANT AWARD YET. HOWEVER, THEY WILL STILL BE ABLE TO MOVE TODAY WITH OBTAINING THE GRANT IF WE APPROVE THIS RESOLUTION.\r\n\r\nI HAVE ASKED MS. KA HULA FROM THE CDBG OFFICE TO BE PRESENT TODAY IN CASE MEMBERS HAVE QUESTIONS. I RESPECTFULLY ASK FOR THE MEMBERS' SUPPORT OF THIS MOTION. >> MEMBERS. ANY OUESTIONS? MS. KA HULA IS IN THE AUDIENCE. MEMBER PALTIN.\r\nGOOD MORNING. YOU ALMOST GOT AWAY WITH NO QUESTIONS. MEMBER PALTIN. >> THANK YOU, CHAIR. THANK YOU, MS. KA HULA AND UNDERSTAND THERE'S A PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANY SELECTED FOR THE ALREADY ACQUIRED UNITS. IS THIS GRANT IS TO MANAGE THAT, OR IS THIS SOMETHING ELSE?\r\n\r\n>> MS. KA HULA. >> THANK YOU, CHAIR, AND THANK YOU, MEMBER PALTIN. THIS GRANT, \$100,000 PROJECT RECOMMENDED FOR FUNDING IS AN ANNUAL OBLIGATION TO SUPPORT THE OR SUBSIDIZE THE RENT BEING THAT WE MAY NOT COLLECT ENOUGH RENT TO PAY THE ASSOCIATION FEES AND ALSO FOR PROPERTY MANAGEMENT SERVICES: >> SO THE PROJECT IS TO SUBSIDIZE THE UNITS THAT WE PURCHASED FOR THE SENIORS WAS SIX OR SO? >> MS. KA HULA. >> THANK YOU, CHAIR.\r\n\r\nTHAT IS CORRECT. AT THE CURRENT MOVEMENT WE HAVE COMPLETED THE ACQUISITION OF FIVE UNITS. WE HAVE TWO MORE PENDING BFED COMMITTEE. AND YES, SO THE FUNDS ARE INTENDED TO SUBSIDIZE THE RENT FOR EACH UNIT, AND PROVIDE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT SERVICES AS WELL. >> CAN YOU SHARE WITH US WHAT THE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT ENTITY THAT HAS BEEN SELECTED, AND THE PROCESS? THAT YOU USED TO SELECT THE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT, AND POSSIBLY A TIME LINE FOR OUR SENIORS TO MOVE IN? PEOPLE HAVE GOTTEN NOTICES TO

VACATE THE HOTELS, AND IT'S SUPER UNSTABLE RIGHT NOW. IS THERE A TIME LINE FOR THESE FIVE SENIORS, AND THEIR HOUSEHOLDS TO MOVE IN?\r\n\r\n>> MS. KA HULA. >> THANK YOU, CHAIR. THE PROCESS THAT WE USE TO SELECT A PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANY WAS KIND OF TWO-FOLD I GUESS YOU COULD SAY. WE PUT OUT AN RFP, BUT I THINK YOU MIGHT RECALL ME SAYING THAT WE DIDN'T GET ANY PROPOSALS OR BIDS SUBMITTED. AND SO THEN WE SOUGHT AN ALTERNATE PROCUREMENT OPTION AND WE HAD TO PIVOT. SO WE GOT APPROVAL TO CONTACT OTHER PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANIES, OR EVEN NONPROFIT AGENCIES THAT DID NOT SUBMIT BIDS.\r\n\r\nAND THEN AT THIS TIME WE, IN FACT, TO-DATE WE ONLY RECEIVED ONE PROPOSAL. AND WE'RE FORTUNATE IN THAT THE OFFER HAD LAHAINA TIES AS WELL. THAT IS WHO WE'RE PROCEEDING WITH. THE EXPECTATION OF THE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANY IS THAT THEY WILL RECEIVE ALREADY ELIGIBLE DETERMINED TENANTS, OR WAIT-LIST, I GUESS, APPLICANTS AT THIS POINT FOR POSSIBLE OCCUPANCY TO EACH UNIT. SO INTERNALLY WITHIN CDBG. WE'RE GOING TO DETERMINE ALL ELIGIBILITY REOUIREMENTS AND MAKE SURE WE'RE COMPLYING WITH ALL CDBG REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS. THEREAFTER WE'LL HAND OVER ONLY ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS TO THE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANY. I HOPE THAT ANSWERS YOUR QUESTION.\r\n\r\n>> ARE YOU NOT ABLE TO SHARE WITH US THE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANY, WHO THEY ARE? , AND WHAT THEY ARE BEING -- WHAT THE TERMS ARE OF THE AGREEMENT? >> GO AHEAD. >> THANK YOU, CHAIR. I THINK AT THIS TIME, I'M GOING TO REFRAIN FROM SHARING THAT ONLY BECAUSE THE CONTRACT IS PENDING DRAFTING IN CORP. COUNSEL. I BELIEVE THAT THE CONTRACT WILL BE EXECUTED, HOWEVER I THINK UNTIL IT IS, I WON'T SHARE THE DETAILS JUST YET.\r\n\r\nI THINK YOU ALSO ASKED ABOUT THE TIMEFRAME IN WHICH WE'LL HOPE TO GET TENANTS IN. I DO REALIZE THE URGENCY. I DO, AND I WISH WE COULD SPEED UP THE PROCESS. THE ACQUISITIONS WERE NEW TO CDBG, MAYBE NOT NECESSARILY NEW TO THE COUNTY, BUT NEW TO CDBG, AND WE HAD TO MAKE SURE BY WORKING WITH THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT AND CORP. COUNSEL THAT WE DID IT CORRECTLY. SO AT THIS POINT, WE HAVE CRAFTED OUR TENANT APPLICATION POLICY AND OTHER ADDENDUMS AS IT PERTAINS TO PETS, AND MAINTENANCE, OR THE RESPONSIBILITIES -- NOT MAINTENANCE, BUT THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TENANTS. THOSE FORMS ARE READY.\r\n\r\nAND SO OUR PLAN IS TO ANNOUNCE THE AVAILABILITY OF UNITS WITHIN THE NEXT COUPLE OF WEEKS AND START RECEIVING APPLICATIONS THAT WE'LL PROCESS INTERNALLY WITH THE TARGET DATE OF GETTING KUPUNA INTO THE UNITS BY THE END OF JUNE OR EARLY JULY. >> SO SINCE NOBODY RESPONDED TO THE RFP, THEN YOU WENT OUT AND CONTACTED PEOPLE, WHEN YOU TOLD US THAT NOBODY RESPONDED TO THE RFP, I TOLD A BUNCH OF FOLKS ABOUT THIS, THAT WE NEEDED A PROPERTY MANAGEMENT TO BE ABLE TO GET PEOPLE INTO THESE UNITS. SOME FOLKS CALLED YOUR OFFICE. THEY DIDN'T GET ANY ANSWER. THERE WAS NO VOICEMAIL SET UP. THEY EMAILED. THEY DIDN'T GET ANY ANSWER FOR OVER A WEEK.\r\n\r\nAND SO I JUST WAS WONDERING, YOU KNOW, IF YOU CANNOT SHARE THE TERMS OF THE CONTRACT, YOU CANNOT SHARE WHO IT IS THAT WAS SELECTED, IT DOESN'T SEEM LIKE AN OPEN AND TRANSPARENT PROCESS. I JUST WILL SAY. >> MS. KA HULA. >> THANK YOU, CHAIR, OKAY, I UNDERSTAND WHAT YOU ARE SAYING, AND THERE'S NO HIDDEN AGENDA.\r\n\r\nTHE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANY -- LET ME JUST BACK UP. WHEN I STARTED REACHING OUT TO PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANIES, I DID CALL A VARIETY. I CALLED HALE AND I CALLED LOKI PACIFIC AND MEO, EVEN THOUGH THEY ARE NOT NECESSARILY A PROPERTY MANAGEMENT, WE'RE LOOKING FOR SOMEONE REPUTABLE, A NONPROFIT, BUT IT DIDN'T WORK OUT. NOBODY HAD THE CAPACITY TO ENTER INTO CONTACT FOR PROPERTY MANAGEMENT SERVICES. THEREAFTER WE STARTED LOOKING AT FOR-PROFITS. I THIS IT WAS GRACE STAR WHO DOES SOME PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMPANY SERVICES FOR DHHC AND WE REACHED OUT TO REALTY, 3150 AND MANY COMPANIES THAT THE COUNTY ALREADY USES FOR DIFFERENT PROGRAMS AND THERE. TOO. WE GOT NO RESPONSES. THEREAFTER THEN I CONTACTED BY RECOMMENDATION EHU PROPERTIES WHICH IS THE COMPANY WE HAVE SELECTED TO WORK WITH.\r\nTO RESPOND TO -- I DID GET A CALL FROM AMBER AT LAHAINA COMMUNITY LAND TRUST AND I APOLOGIZE. WE HAD SOME PHONE ISSUES AND I DIDN'T KNOW MY VOICEMAIL WASN'T WORKS. I CONNECTED WITH YOU AND MY REQUEST WENT TO CORP. COUNSEL IN EARLY APRIL AND I KNOW THEY ARE BUSY, AND JUST WAIT ING FOR THAT CONTRACT TO BE DRAFTED. IN THE CONVERSATION WITH AMBER, IT WAS, YOU KNOW, WE'RE

ENTERING INTO A ONE-YEAR CONTRACT. AND THEREAFTER, THEY ARE SET UP, MEANING LAHAINA LAND TRUST, IF THEY ARE SET UP WOULD ABSOLUTELY BE WILLING TO PUT IN ANOTHER RFP AND SEE WHAT COMES OF THAT. >> THANK YOU.\r\n\I APPRECIATE THE EXPLANATION. I DON'T KNOW AN AMBER, BUT MAYBE YOU ARE REFERRING TO AUTUMN? >> MS. KA HULA . >> THANK, CHAIR. SORRY, YES, IT'S AUTUMN, I APOLOGIZE. >> THANK YOU. I APPRECIATE THE INFORMATION.\r\n\r\n>> ANY MORE COMMENTS OR QUESTIONS, MEMBERS? IF NOT, THANK YOU, MS. KA HULA. READY FOR THE VOTE? ALL THOSE IN FAVOR OF THE MOTION, RAISE YOUR HAND, SAY AYE? EIGHT AYES, ZERO NOS, ONE EXCUSED. MOTION CARRIES.\r\n\r\nEXCUSED IS MEMBER COOK. MS. CLERK. >> CHAIR, THERE'S NO FURTHER BUSINESS BEFORE THE COUNCIL. >> I'M SORRY, VICE-CHAIR SUGIMURA, WHAT DID YOU SAY >> LOOK AT THE TIME. IT'S NOT EVEN 10:00. >> I KNOW. >> WOW.\r\n\r\n>> YOU WANTED PRODUCTIVE AND WE TRIED VERY HARD. MEMBERS, ANY LAST COMMENTS? ARE YOU GOING TO THE CHARITY WALK TOMORROW? EVERYBODY IS SO TIRED. >> EXHAUSTED. I BETTER WOULD PUT THAT ON MY RADAR. >> NOBODY JINXED US.\r\n\r\nI HOPE NOBODY JINXED US. >> GREAT. SUGIMURA, YOU HAD YOUR HAND UP ER I WANTED TO THANK THE CLERK'S OFFICE. WE ALL HAVE NEW PLASTIC WHATEVER THIS IS CALLED TO PROTECT THE CARPET FROM OUR -- I MEAN, MY PLASTIC WAS CRACKED, BUT YOU JUST THINK OH, WELL, THAT IS THE WAY IT IS. THANK YOU. >> THE REASON WHY WE COULDN'T CHANGE IT, BECAUSE IT'S OF HIS HISTORIC VALUE [LAUGHTER]OVER 50 YEARS OLD. SO WE HAVE TO GO THROUGH ALL THE GOVERNMENTAL PROCESSES TO BUY THE NEW ONES.\r\n\r\nANY MORE COMMENTS? EVERYBODY HAS A SAFE WEEK, TAKE CARE, GOD BLESS. THIS MEETING IS ADJOURNED. [GAVEL]
