A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI. APPENDIX A, PART II, GENERAL EXCISE TAX FUND. WILDFIRE PERMANENT DISPOSAL SITE AND APPENDIX C. **DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT** 

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5657, Bill No. 60, CD1, FD2 (2024), as amended "Fiscal Year 2025 Budget", Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues - Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2025, General Excise Tax Fund, is amended to increase the second condition by \$8,000,000 and decrease the third condition by the same amount, to read as follows:

- CC. General Excise Tax Fund (Chapter 3.100, Maui County Code)
  - (1) Up to \$5,000,000 must be for the Kamole Weir Water Treatment Facility in Makawao, Maui, Hawai'i.
  - (2) Up to [\$16,000,000] \$24,000,000 must be for land acquisition, design, construction, and permitting of the wildfire permanent disposal site.
  - (3) Up to [\$17,400,000] \$9,400,000 must be for operations and maintenance of the wildfire permanent disposal site.
  - (4) Up to \$2,000,000 must be for wildfire debris removal.
  - (5) Up to \$16,668,000 must be for water infrastructure repairs and replacement, and wastewater repairs related to the August 2023 Wildfires.
  - (6) Up to \$2,000,000 must be for the Kahului Wastewater Treatment Plant 4th Aeration Basin.

(7) Up to \$10,000,000 must be for funding for the acquisition of private water systems and wells to align with the Department of Water Supply's vision to integrate public and private water systems and develop a municipal water system.

SECTION 2. Fiscal Year 2025 Budget, Appendix C – Capital Improvement Projects, Department of Management, Countywide, Wildfire Permanent Disposal Site, is amended to increase the appropriation by \$8,000,000, to read as follows:

This bill proposes to amend the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget, by: 1) amending Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues - Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2025, General Excise Tax Fund, by a) increasing the amount in condition 2 for design, construction, and permitting of the Wildfire Permanent Disposal Site from \$16,000,000 to \$24,000,000; and b) decreasing the amount in condition 3 for operations and maintenance of the Wildfire Permanent Disposal Site from \$17,400,000 to \$9,400,000; and 2) amending Appendix C - Capital Improvement Projects, Department of Management, Countywide, Wildfire Permanent Disposal Site, by increasing the appropriation from \$16,000,000 to \$24,000,000.
