I have known Greg Brown and company for 5 years; when we bought a home from him in the Coffee Farms. As a family of general contractors we can appreciate the fine quality that Greg puts into his product; first class all the way.

I have no doubt this development will be more of the same.

This “workforce” product provides much needed relief for commuters that travel everyday from Wailuku, Kahului, Kihei (east end) etc. to work on the west side. It has to be in the hundreds if not thousands.

By being able to eliminate those commutes...Maui will be a better place to liveas this development will clean the environment (clean air) and lessen traffic and road impacts as a direct result of providing this badly needed housing.
