Thank you for the opportunity to respond to your request on “how effective has the assignment of equivalent personnel under the Department of Management been on projects within our department.”

The assistance from personnel under the Department of Management was instrumental in the completion of Maui Police Department’s capital improvement projects: The renovations of the Molokai Police Cottage and the renovations of the Maui Police Department’s Records and Evidence Section. These projects could not have been successfully completed without their assistance.

At this time, the Department of Management is assisting with the design and installation of our medical waste incinerator. We are also moving forward with other pending CIP projects which include the design and renovation of the Wailuku Police Dispatch Center
