AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT OF DUKIE J. RACADIO V. COUNTY OF MAUI, ET AL. CIVIL NO. 14-1-0451(2)

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Dukie J. Racadio filed a lawsuit in the Second Circuit Court of the State of Hawai'i, Civil No. 14-1-0451(2), against the County of Maui on August 1, 2014, asserting a discrimination claim, following termination from employment with the Department of Police owing to a disqualifying medical condition; and

WHEREAS, the County of Maui, to avoid incurring expenses and the uncertainty of a judicial determination of the parties' respective rights and liabilities, seeks to reach a resolution of this case by way of a negotiated settlement or Offer of Judgment; and
