On behalf of the Department of Public Works, I am transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, ESTIMATED REVENUES; CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, COUNTYWIDE, GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, BOND FUND, COUNTYWIDE DPW BASEYARD FACILITIES PROGRAM; AND Alice L. Lee, Chair April 25, 2025 Page 2

APPENDIX C, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, COUNTYWIDE, DPW BASEYARD FACILITIES PROGRAM."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget to: 1) increase Estimated Revenues, Bond/Lapsed Bond Fund and Total Estimated Revenues by \$4,200,000; 2) increase the appropriation under Capital Improvement Projects, Department of Public Works, Countywide, Government Facilities, Bond Fund, Countywide DPW Baseyard Facilities Program by \$4,200,000; 3) increase both Total Capital Improvement Project Appropriations and Total Appropriations by \$4,200,000; and 4) increase Appendix C, Department of Public Works, Countywide, Countywide DPW Baseyard Facilities Program by \$4,200,000.

2. A proposed bill, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5659, BILL 62, CD 1 (2024), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend Ordinance No. 5659, Bill No. 62, CD1 (2024), to increase the appropriation under the Department of Public Works, Countywide, Government Facilities, Countywide DPW Baseyard Facilities Program by \$4,200,000 and to increase the total by the same amount.

These funds are for the Central-South Baseyard Relocation land purchase and will be used for the acquisition of 220 Lalo Street in Kahului, Maui. The resolution for this acquisition along with the appraisal will be transmitted for consideration at the May 16, 2025 Council meeting.

There are currently competing offers for the property, and the Administration is requesting floor action on this item.

### BILL NO. <u>62</u> (2025)

### A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5659, BILL NO. 62, CD 1 (2024), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS)

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5659, Bill No. 62, CD1 (2024), is amended by amending

Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. <u>Authorization of General Obligation Bonds</u>. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$109,973,839] <u>\$114,173,839</u> (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof."

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 5659, Bill No. 62, CD1 (2024), is amended by

amending Section 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (the "Fiscal Year 2025 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which is in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
