Chair and Members:

Your Parks, Recreation, Energy, and Legal Affairs Committee, having met on May 16, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 17-6, from Council Chair Mike White, relating to litigation matters.

By correspondence dated May 10, 2017, the Department of the Corporation Counsel requested consideration of the possible settlement of William A. Melton v. County of Maui, Disability Compensation Division Case 7-14-02000. Attached to the request is a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT OF WILLIAM A. MELTON V. COUNTY OF MAUI, DISABILITY COMPENSATION DIVISION CASE NO. 7-14-02000." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize the Department to settle the case.

Your Committee notes Section 3.16.020(A), Maui County Code, requires Council authorization for any settlement of a workers' compensation claim in excess of the authority granted by that provision.

A Deputy Corporation Counsel provided a brief overview of the case. He said the workers' compensation claim involves a retired police officer who was injured while assisting in the arrest of an intoxicated male in Kihei, Maui, Hawaii. According to the proposed resolution, the injuries were sustained on September 8, 2014.

Because the case involves ongoing litigation and confidential medical information, the Deputy requested the opportunity to convene an executive meeting.



Your Committee voted to convene an executive meeting, closed to the public, to consult with legal counsel pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes; and Section 92-5(a)(8), Hawaii Revised Statutes, to deliberate or make a decision upon a matter that requires the consideration of information that must be kept confidential pursuant to a State or Federal law, or a court order.

Following the executive meeting, your Committee reconvened in regular session. Based on the information received and the recommendation of the Department, your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend adoption of the proposed resolution. Committee Chair Guzman and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Hokama, Sugimura, and White voted "aye." Committee Vice-Chair King was excused.

Your Parks, Recreation, Energy, and Legal Affairs Committee **RECOMMENDS** that Resolution _____, attached hereto, entitled "AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT OF WILLIAM A. MELTON V. COUNTY OF MAUI, DISABILITY COMPENSATION DIVISION CASE NO. 7-14-02000," be **ADOPTED**.

WHEREAS, Claimant William A. Melton filed a Workers' Compensation Claim alleging work-related injuries sustained on September 8, 2014; and

WHEREAS, having reviewed the facts and circumstances regarding this matter and being advised of the proposed settlement by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, the Council wishes to authorize the settlement of the Workers' Compensation Claim under the terms and conditions proposed in an executive meeting before the Parks, Recreation, Energy, and Legal Affairs Committee ; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it hereby approves settlement of William A. Melton v. County of Maui, Disability Compensation Division Case No. 7-14-02000, under the terms set forth in an executive meeting before the Parks, Recreation, Energy, and Legal Affairs Committee; and

2. That it hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement on behalf of the County in this case; and


