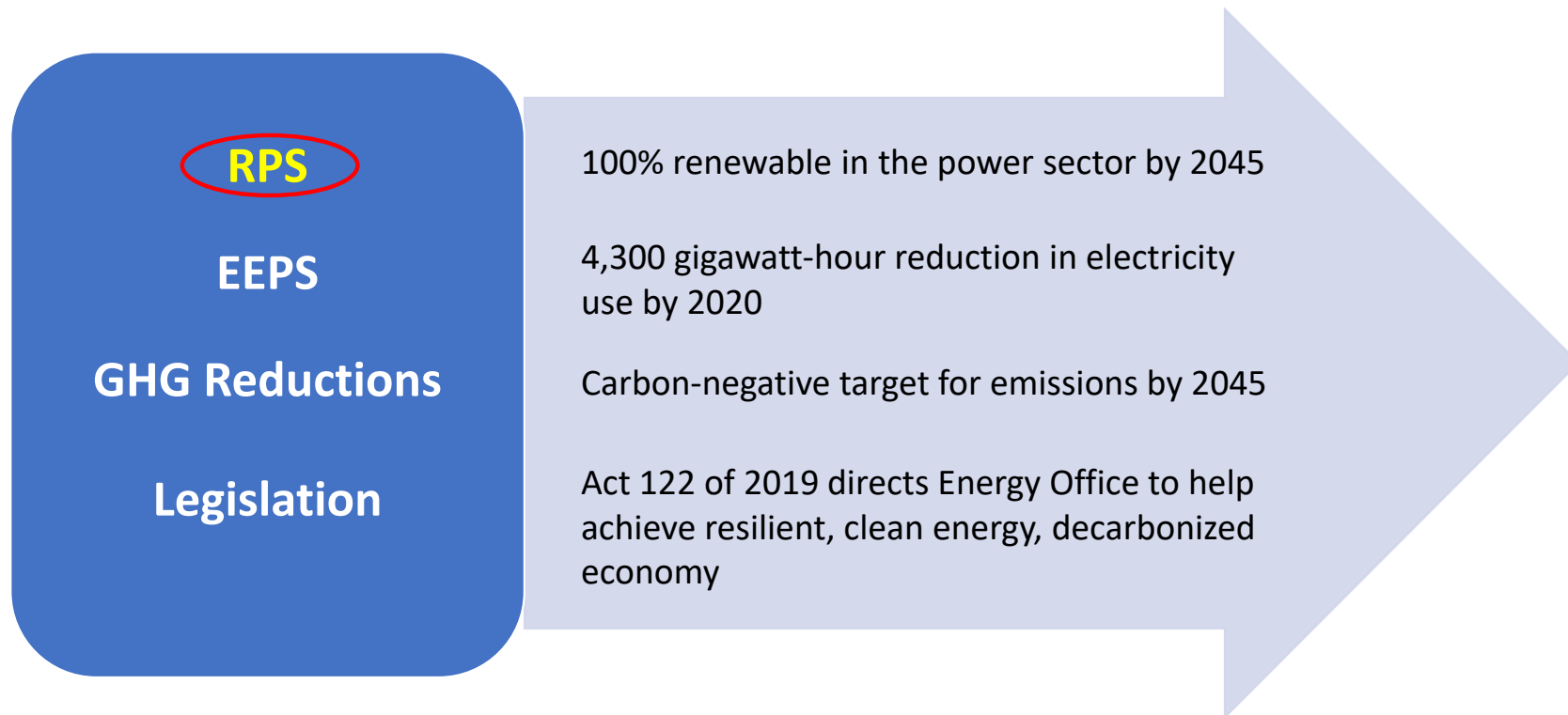

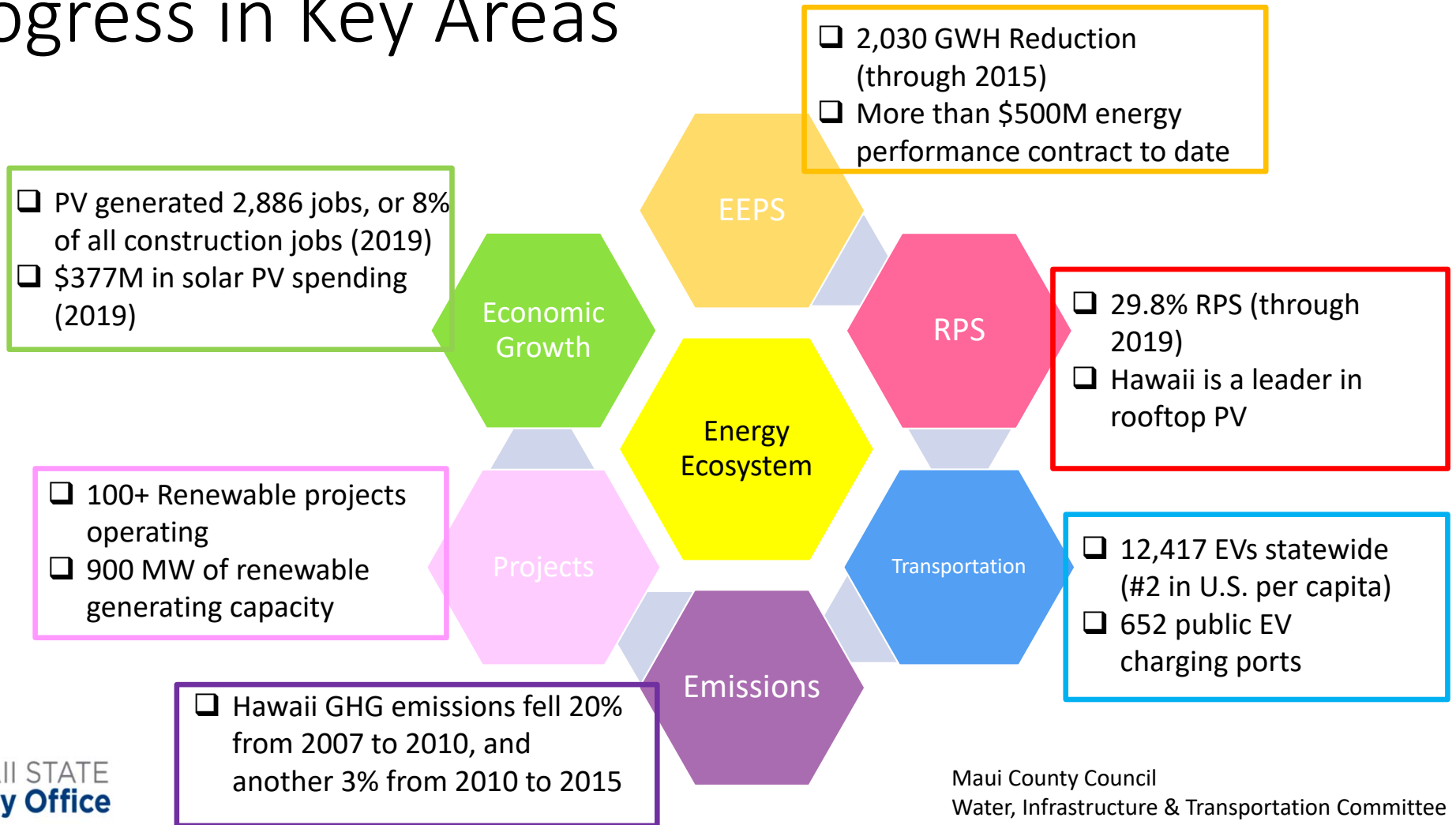


Drivers of Hawaii's Clean Energy Transformation

Community-based Renewable Energy (CBRE)

Established in Hawaii by Act 100 in 2015

- **Issue:**

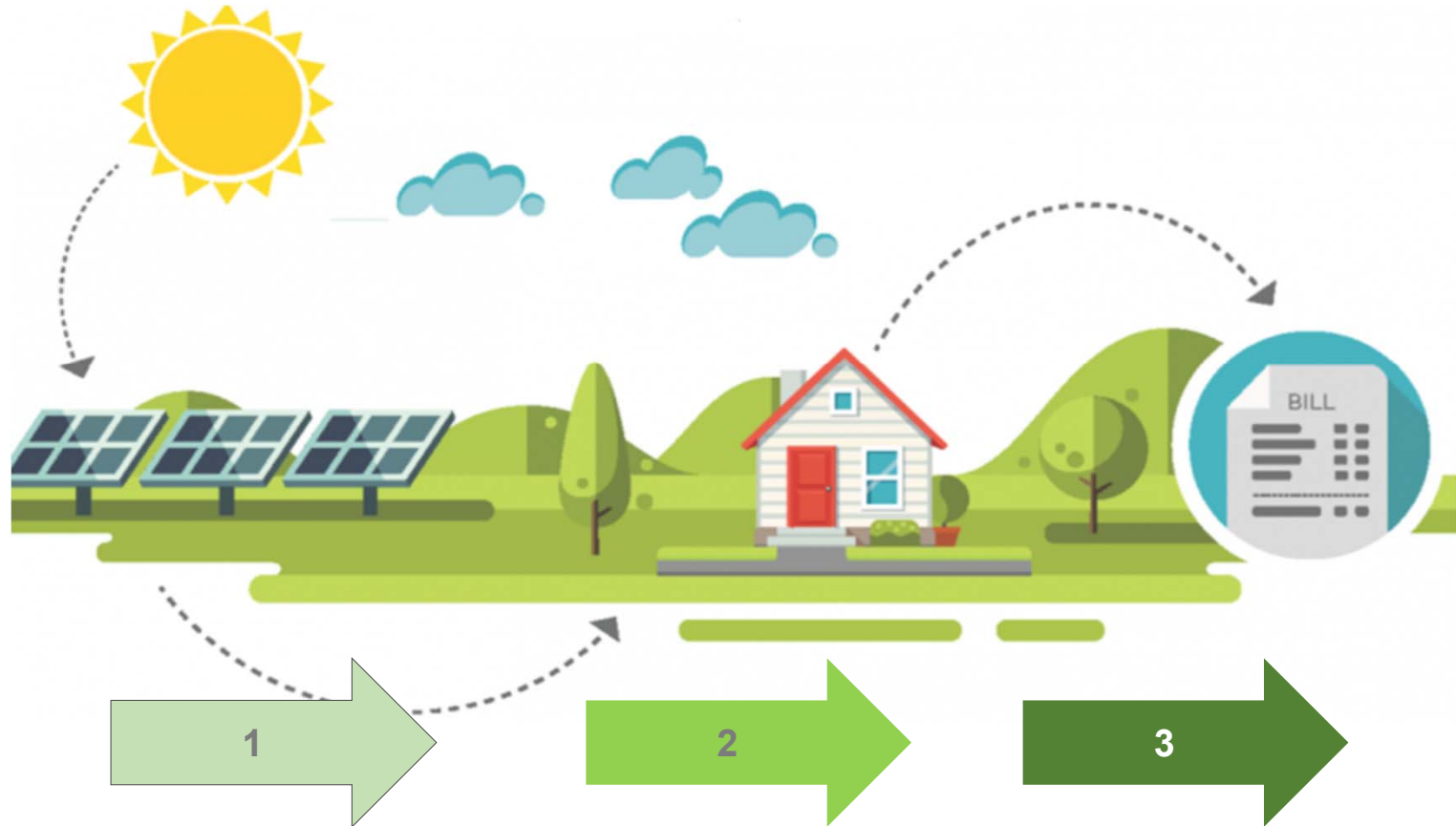
Many residents and businesses are currently unable to directly participate in renewable energy generation because of their location, building type, access to the electric utility grid, and other impediments.

- **Solution:**

Extend direct participation in renewable energy projects to:

- Residential and business renters;
- Occupants of residential and commercial buildings with shaded or improperly oriented roofs; and
- Other groups who are unable to access the benefits of onsite clean energy generation
