### MAUI ISLAND WATER USE AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN (WAI-37)

**Description:** The Committee received County Communication 19-162, from the Director of Water Supply, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN UPDATE TO THE WATER USE AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE ISLAND OF MAUI."
