A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
SECTION 14.13.050, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO
DEADLINE FOR RESPONSE TO UPCOUNTRY WATER METER OFFER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 14.13.050, Maui County Code, is amended to read
as follows:

“14.13.050 Procedure for processing applications for water service from the priority list. A. When an applicant owning property on the priority list requesting new or additional water service is approved for such service, the applicant shall be notified in writing by certified mail, return receipt requested, at the address submitted on the application.

B. The applicant shall be given [~~thirty~~] sixty days from the date the certified mail was received by the applicant to complete and deliver to the department an application for water service or to reserve an allocation of water service in accordance with the department's established rules, regulations, and procedures.

C. Failure to respond or the return of an unsigned return receipt will be treated as a refusal of water service.”

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


This bill proposes to amend Section 14.13.050, Maui County Code, to extend the time applicants are given to reserve an allocation of water service from 30 to 60 days.
