Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on February 27, 2018, makes reference to County Communication 17-443, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE 1. AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES: DEPARTMENT OF **PUBLIC** WORKS. KIHEI-MAKENA COMMUNITY **PLAN** AREA. **ROAD** IMPROVEMENTS. **PAVEMENT** REHABILITATION VARIOUS LOCATIONS - SOUTH MAUI: TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS: AND TOTAL **APPROPRIATIONS** (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purposed of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2018 Budget by 1) increasing Estimated Revenues from the Bond Fund by \$1,852,716; 2) amending Section 4.J.3.a.(1), by adding an appropriation of \$1,852,716 under the Department of Public Works ("Department"), Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area, Road Improvements, Bond Fund, for Pavement Rehabilitation at Various Locations – South Maui ("Project"); and 3) adjusting the totals accordingly.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4454, BILL NO. 63 (2017), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS—SOUTH MAUI)."

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The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2018 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by adding an appropriation of \$1,852,716 under the Department, Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area, Road Improvements, for the Project.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, KIHEI-MAKENA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS - SOUTH MAUI."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2018 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding an appropriation of \$1,852,716 and a project description under the Department, Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area, for the Project.

Your Committee notes the FY 2017 Budget appropriated \$1,860,000 in Bond Funds for the Project. The Department expended \$7,284 of the total appropriation prior to the funds lapsing on December 31, 2017. Because an error in one of the bid items resulted in the project having to go out for bid again, the Project was delayed and the remaining appropriation of \$1,852,716 lapsed.

The Director of Public Works said the funds will be used to rehabilitate the following South Maui streets: Kulanihakoi, Waipuilani, Lipoa, and Welakahao.

He said the Department completed the planning and design phase for the Project and placed the Project out for bid. A bid protest was filed with the State Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs. The Department anticipates a ruling on the bid protest soon. Pending the ruling, an appeal may be filed with the Circuit Court for a final decision

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on the bid protest. If an appeal is filed, the Circuit Court has 60 days to make its final decision.

The Director said \$4,000,000 in Federal funds were awarded for the Project. He said the proposed amendment provides the County's required matching funds for the Project. The Director said the Federal Highway Administration has been informed about the bid protest, and the County has requested an extension of the deadline to use the funds.

At the request of the Director, your Committee included drainline improvements to the project description in Appendix C. He said repairs and improvements are needed to drainage pipes located beneath the roadway.

The Budget Director clarified the FY 2017 bond appropriation was not encumbered or floated.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, King, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee member Guzman was excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of revised proposed bills, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the FY 2018 Budget.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4454, BILL NO. 63 (2017), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS-SOUTH MAUI)

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4454, Bill No. 63 (2017), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

SECTION 1. <u>Authorization of General Obligation Bonds</u>. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$49,985,000] <u>\$51,837,716</u> (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof.

SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (the "Fiscal Year 2018 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
