Study Focus and Methodology

- Identify issues, unnecessary complexities and causes of delays that prevent timely completion of the community plan process.
- Conduct stakeholder outreach to gather input.
- Analyze the current practices and procedures related to the community plan process.
- Analyze and recommend law, policy and procedural changes to expedite and improve the community plan review process.

Key Recommendations:

Community Engagement

- Transition CPAC to Citizen working group
- Reduce timeframe to 10 months (6 months for community engagement and 4 months to draft initial plan)

Planning Commission

- Limit to 6 meetings
- Reduce timeframe to 4 months

County Council:

- → Focus on reviewing plan for policy impacts and decisions including narrative on policy elements of community plan.
- Eliminate Planning and Sustainable Land Use Committee review and provide to entire County Council for review.
- Limit timeframe to 6 months





Key Recommendations:

Process and Staffing

- Remove implementation plan requirement and focus on 20-year capital project plan
- Planning staff should work collaboratively with Planning Commission and County Council staff on edits to the plan.
- Time extensions should be limited to one per phase for a maximum one month time period.
- Automatic adoption of Planning Commission version if not approved by Council in prescribed timeframe.
- 1.5 additional staff in Planning Department required to meet 20 month timeframe and conduct two plan updates simultaneously
