**SUBJECT: MORATORIUM ON EXPORTING SAND, THE MAUI
INLAND SAND RESOURCE QUANTIFICATION STUDY
AND SAND MINING REGULATION (IEM-33)**

Thank you for your assistance with providing Geographic Information Systems (GIS) staff at the Council's Infrastructure and Environmental Management Committee meeting of August 14, 2017. The mapping and displays provided by GIS were very helpful with the Committee's deliberations.

The Committee is considering a proposed bill that would declare a moratorium on sand mining in Central Maui. The Committee wishes to focus the affected area of the moratorium on vacant land, sand dunes, historical, cultural, and environmentally sensitive areas of Central Maui. The Committee also directed that the affected area of the moratorium should not include developed residential and commercial areas.

Therefore, in an effort to clearly define the affected area of the moratorium may I respectfully request that you provide a map and description of sites as stated above from Waihe'e River to Kealia Pond in the Central Maui area. Please exclude developed areas or areas already subdivided for construction.

Thank you for your consideration of this request. May I also request that you provide your response by **August 29, 2017**, I intend on scheduling this matter for discussion at the meeting of September 12, 2017.
