## A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, APPENDIX A, PART I, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5528, Bill No. 22, CD1, FD2 (2023), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2024 Budget", Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2024, Office of the Mayor, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program is amended by deleting projects for Maui Family Support Services, Inc. and County of Maui, Department of Fire and Public Safety; adding a project for County of Maui; increasing the total amount allocated to the program by \$1,478,750; and deleting the overall appropriation for the program and appropriating the funds by project, to read as follows:
