The County of Maui's Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR) audit requires the Employees' Retirement System (ERS) schedule of allocations to be audited in accordance with the Governmental Accounting Standards Board Statement No. 68. The State of Hawaii's Office of the Auditor has hired an external auditor to audit the ERS schedule of allocations as required for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2022, 2023, and 2024.

The purposes of this proposed bill are as follows: 1) To authorize the Mayor to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Hawaii, Office of the Auditor, which includes

execution of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), all other necessary documents relating to the MOU, and any other amendments thereto, and; 2) To authorize the payment of \$3,700.00 for fiscal year 2022, \$3,900.00 for fiscal year 2023, and \$4,100.00 for fiscal year 2024 as the County of Maui's share for the audit.
